


Learning Objectives

Cooperative learning


Learning Responsibilities

is a learning strategy in which small groups of students work together on a common task in order to take advantage of their interaction and maximise the learning experience of anyone. Thanks to this learning strategy, the students will learn Objectives and Responsibilities at the same time. The learning process will happen both at individual and at team level because each student is motivated to get involved and play his/her part within the group. The team itself is a learning facilitator and a skills learning instrument.


